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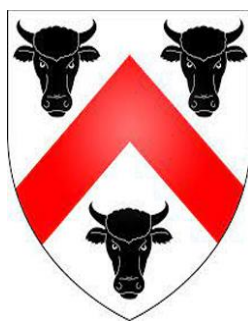
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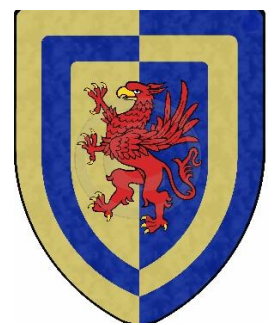
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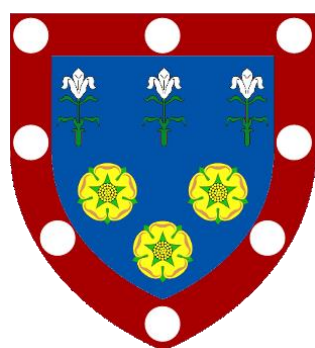
OTHER FREQUENTLY-MET CHARGES

Heraldic Rose

This is usually of five petals. By default the sepals at the edges of the petals are green and the seeds yellow. In this case the rose is *barbed and seeded proper*.



Per bend sinister argent and sable a rose gules barbed and seeded proper



Azure three lily stems and flowers palewise in fess proper above three roses or 2 & 1 barbed and seeded proper all within a bordure gules charged with eight plates

Buckle

There seems to be no official default for buckles. Unofficially the default shape appears to be round with its tongue pointing to the dexter.



Sable a buckle silver

Sable a round buckle tongue to the dexter silver



Azure on a bend ermine three buckles gules

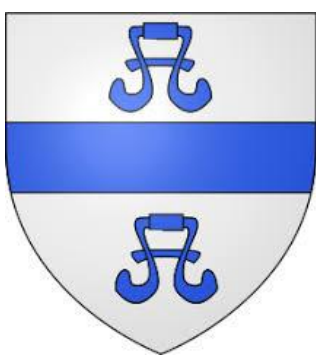
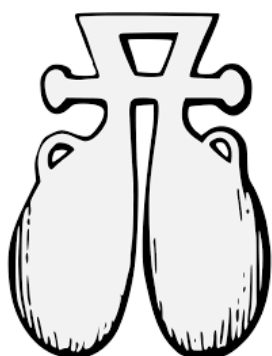
Millrind

Made of iron, a millrind holds the upper mill wheel in place while allowing grain to pass through the middle.



Water Bouget

Historically these were carried on the shoulders of soldiers to transport water.

The heraldic lymphad or galley is often shown with the two ends symmetrical. Some details should be specified.

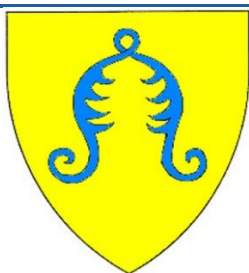


Argent a lymphad

Exercise 1

1. Gules a chevron ermine between three dolphins naiant embowed argent
2. Sable a fess wavy or between three wolves' heads erased argent langued gules
3. Sable a fess cotised between three martlets or
4. Argent a dragon segreant gules holding in his front claws a flagpole erect or displaying a flag sable a cross or
5. Per pale argent and azure a pallet gules between to the dexter a tower or and to the sinister a fish urinant silver
6. Gules a wyvern argent holding between its claws a chequerboard azure and or
7. Argent a chevron gules between three cows' heads caboshed sable
8. Gules three fish naiant in bend or
9. Argent a lion rampant sable standing on a snake fesswise with head to the dexter vert all within an orle of eight trefoils of the last
10. Per pale or and azure a gryphon segreant gules armed and langued or within an orle counter changed

Exercise 2

1. Argent on a bend sable three buckles or and in dexter chief a maunch of the second
2. Or three water bougets gules
3. Argent on a cross azure five pheons or
4. Azure on a chevron between three mullets or a buckle of the field
5. Per fess azure and gules a horse bray argent within an annulet or
6. Argent a saltire wavy between four roses gules barbed and seeded proper
7. Azure twelve millrinds or 4, 4, 3 & 1 on a canton of the second a lion rampant of the first armed and langued gules
8. Per fess or and azure, in chief to the dexter a dexter hand fesswise couped at the wrist holding a dagger erect and to the sinister a cross crosslet fitchy gules, in base a lymphad sails furled oars active or with pennants flying gules
9. Azure three horse barnacles in pale or on a chief ermine a demi-lion gules
10. Per bend argent and gules three roses in bend counterchanged barbed and seeded proper
